Jerald R. Wheeler is Executive Director, Water and Wastewater Group, for the Maryland Environmental Service (MES). He is responsible for all aspects of the Maryland Environmental Service's Water and Wastewater Group, including financing, engineering design, construction inspection, laboratory testing, operation, maintenance and facility supervision. The MES Water and Wastewater Group is composed of 220 operators, engineers and maintenance personnel who operate and maintain more than 215 water and wastewater treatment plants across Maryland, ensuring a safe drinking water supply and minimizing the environmental impact of residential and industrial wastewater discharges.

Prior to joining MES, Mr. Wheeler served as Director of Public Works for Harford County. Previously he managed the Harford County Department of Public Works' Water and Sewer Division for 15 years and the Engineering Division for 10 years. He earned a Bachelor's degree in civil engineering from the University of Maryland, and is a certified Professional Engineer (P.E.).
