

RICHARD EBERHART HALL

Richard Eberhart Hall was named Secretary of Planning by Governor Martin O'Malley in January 2007. He began working in the Maryland Department of Planning in January 1992 as a Planner IV, moving up to be a Principal Planner. From 2003 until he was named Secretary, he was Director of Land Use Planning and Analysis for the department.

Previously, Secretary Hall was Senior Planner for the Harford County Department of Planning and Zoning from 1989 to 1992, and he formerly held several planning jobs in North Carolina.

Secretary Hall earned a Master's Degree in City and Regional Planning from the University of North Carolina, and a Bachelor's Degree from East Carolina University.
