

## MAYOR ROBERT E. BRUCHEY II

Robert E. Bruchey II has been the Mayor of Hagerstown since March 2006. In that capacity, he governs the City of Hagerstown, represents the city to county and state legislators, defends city economic development issues, and manages key city personnel, including the City Administrator, Chief of Police, Finance Director, Human Resources Director and other department heads. He previously served as Hagerstown's Mayor from May 1997 to May 2001. During his first term in office, he successfully lobbied the state, the county and the business community to bring the University of Maryland Education Center to downtown Hagerstown, turning a dilapidated city-owned building into a \$14 million state-of-the-art institution. Mayor Bruchey also was instrumental in bringing over \$600 million worth of new development to Hagerstown. He also has worked in management, vehicle sales, Internet commerce and law enforcement.
