Scott Kelly is a principal at Re:Vision Architecture, a Philadelphia architecture and planning firm committed to re-visioning and restoring the balance between natural and built environments. Mr. Kelly began his career with historic preservation and adaptive re-use projects, and he became interested in the building elements and methods that cause buildings to endure. He also studied how buildings were designed to work with nature prior to mechanical heating and cooling. While Mr. Kelly was an early adopter of the U.S. Green Building Council's LEED benchmarking system, his work continues with several "living and zero energy" projects.

Mr. Kelly serves as co-chair of the Philadelphia AIA Committee on the Environment and is a founding board member of the Delaware Valley Green Building Council. In addition to leading the way with green architecture, he also consults for design firms, developers, building owners and manufacturers who are interested in green design, sustainable design and LEED certification. He has worked on over 100 LEED projects around the nation, including several platinum level.
