WHEREAS, Caroline County recognizes that economic development is essential to a strong business climate, job creation and retention, a stable tax base, and the quality of life of our residents; and

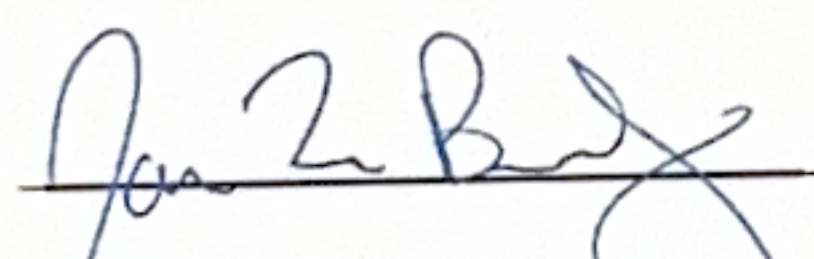
WHEREAS, economic development supports local businesses and entrepreneurs, strengthens our workforce, and fosters collaboration among businesses, organizations, schools, and government; and

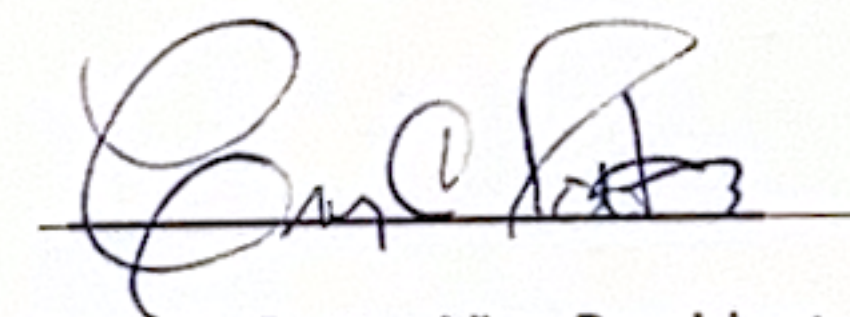

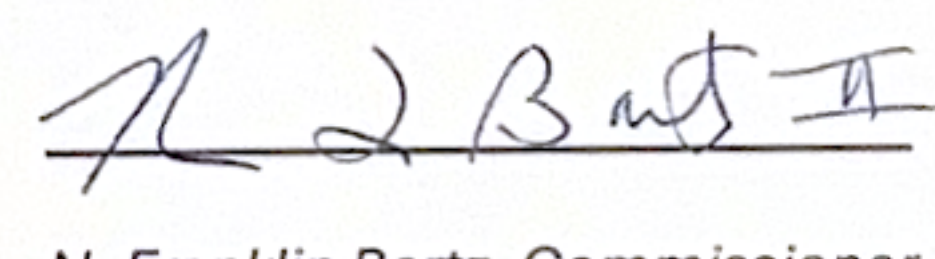
